Materials List

Materials for the first day of the class:

- Visual Research: This could be in the form of drawings, pictures, advertisements, magazine and newspaper cutouts, posters, writing etc. This is to be used as an image resource for your prints. Think about what interests you. This could be digital or in the form of an actual physical file. Start collecting this material so that we can have a discussion in the class about your visuals.
- A notebook or a journal, other stationary such as pen, markers, highlighters and scissors.

Materials for the rest of the course:

- 4-5 yards of fabric: cotton, polyester, natural or synthetic blends are all okay. You could bring one fabric or pieces of different fabrics.
- Fabric printing inks (Transparent and Opaque).
- Rubber Gloves (Dishwashing Gloves), Apron, rags to clean. Wear clothes that you don't mind getting a little messy.
- Plastic Spatulas, Plastic airtight containers to store remaining inks.
- Drawing fluid and Screen filler.
- Paint Brushes (Flat and round)
- Readymade Stencils
- Recycled stencils
