- Art Camp: Held at Morean Arts Center, 719 Central Ave, St. Petersburg
- Clay Camp: Held at Morean Center for Clay, 420 22nd St S, St. Petersburg

General Information

Teacher/Camper Ratios & Group Details:

- Yellow Group Art (1st-2nd Grade):
 - o Ages: 6–7 years old
 - o Ratio: 1 teacher, 1 assistant
 - o Maximum: 15 campers
 - o Note: No kindergarten campers are accepted.
- Blue Group Art (3rd-5th Grade):
 - o Ages: 8–10 years old
 - o Ratio: 1 teacher, 1 assistant
 - o Maximum: 15 campers
- Teen Camps (6th-10th Grade):
 - o Ages: 11–16 years old
 - Smaller groups (max 10 campers)
 - o Ratio: 1 teacher
 - o Focus: More intensive, studio-specific projects

Daily Activities

• 1st-5th Grades:

- Hands-on art projects using various processes (e.g., clay, watercolor, mono printing, oil pastel resist)
- Activities: Teacher-guided and self-guided exploration, plus time with books, puzzles, and manipulatives.
- Special Event: Tour of the Chihuly Collection (720 Central Ave) during the week.

• Teen Camps:

o Focused studio work tailored to their chosen medium and equipment.

Artwork Pick-Up:

- All artwork goes home on Fridays.
- Art left after **August 16th** becomes the property of the Morean.

Themes

Themes are used as a foundation for creative exploration, incorporating cultural art, language arts, art history, or inspiration from master artists.

First Day Procedures

Art Camp (Morean Arts Center 719 Central Ave, St. Petersburg):

- Monday Check-In:
 - Time: 8:45–9:00 AM (mandatory)
 - Location: First floor of the Morean Arts Center
- Drop-Off (Tues-Fri):
 - o Time: 8:55 AM (no students will be allowed inside the building before 8:55)
 - Location: 7th Street entrance (curbside drop-off available)
- Pick-Up:
 - o Time: 3:00 PM (curbside pick-up daily)
 - o Note: Multiple late pick-ups may result in removal from camp.

Clay Camp (Morean Center for Clay 420 22nd St S, St. Petersburg):

- Monday Check-In:
 - o Time: 8:45-9:00 AM
 - Location: Main entrance
- Drop-Off (Tues-Fri):
 - Time: 8:55 AM (no students will be allowed inside the building before 8:55)
- Pick-Up:
 - o Time: 3:00 PM (curbside pick-up daily)
 - o Note: Multiple late pick-ups may result in removal from camp.

Camp Essentials

Dress Code:

- Dress for mess! Wear comfortable clothes like jeans, sneakers, and T-shirts.
- Closed-toe shoes are required (no flip-flops or Heelys).

What to Bring:

- Lunch, water bottle, and creativity!
- Leave toys, tablets, and games at home. Phones (if necessary) must stay in backpacks.
- The Morean is not responsible for lost or damaged items.

Snacks & Lunch:

- Bring snacks and drinks for breaks.
- No food sharing is allowed.
- Lunches are not refrigerated; include an ice pack if needed.

Extended Care:

No extended care is offered.

Scholarships/Financial Assistance:

- Scholarships are available based on financial need.

Registration & Refund Policy:

- **Registration**: Payment required at registration; first-come, first-served.
- Transfers: \$25 fee, subject to availability.
- **Cancellations**: Camps may be canceled if minimum enrollment is not met (full refund provided).
- Refunds: Withdraw at least two weeks before camp start date for a refund (minus \$50 fee).
 No refunds within two weeks of camp start.
- **PLEASE NOTE:** To ensure the best experience for all campers, students must have **completed Kindergarten** before attending any camp at the Morean Arts Center. Registering an **incoming** Kindergarten student will result in removal from camp without a refund.

Additionally, all students must be placed in their **age-appropriate class**. For example, a student entering 3rd grade must be registered for the **3rd–5th grade camp**, while a student entering 2nd grade must be in the **1st–2nd grade camp**, even if they wish to be with a friend in a different age group. Registering a student for the incorrect camp may result in reassignment to the correct group or removal from camp if space is unavailable.
